DID YOU USE DESCRIPTORS AND STATISTICS TO SHOW THE POSITIVE AND TANGIBLE IMPACT YOU HAD IN A PREVIOUS ROLE?

Example: "Created a dynamic sales strategy that boosted quarterly sales activity by 17% and increased division profits by 12.6%''



DID YOU OR A PEER DOUBLE CHECK YOUR RESUME FOR SPELLING, PUNCTUATION, AND GRAMMATICAL ERRORS?

Example: Incorrect "Skilled in adobe illustrator photoshop and in design" vs. Correct "Skilled in Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, and InDesign"



HAVE YOU HIGHLIGHTED BOTH INDIVIDUAL SUCCESSES AND TEAMWORK?

Example: "My team collaborated and created a new marketing template for our company increasing overall engagement by 11.3%"
